I see the problem now.

Mailman is using http URLs but my browser (firefox) is respecting the pinned HSTS configuration of bitfolk.com and so redirecting to https before even requesting it. The https version works, but the http version doesn't.

Presumably you are using some browser like Safari which doesn't request https on such domains. I am able to replicate the problem with lynx (!) and will use that to test that I have added server-side redirection to https, for the sake of people with bookmarks and old links.

In the mean time I have corrected the URLs in the Mailman interface to be the https version.

Thanks for the fix. I think my browser was missing the HSTS data - I'm using Chrome but with a new browser profile, and had never visited bitfolk.com itself on it. When visiting bitfolk.com, I see the STS header and then lists.bitfolk.com I see the internal browser redirect, so appears to work properly from then on (as does the redirect itself).
