| Description: | <p>The "arch" command alters the bootloader defined in the guest config, but guests don't see config updates until their next creation. Rebooting a guest does not create a new VM, it just re-uses the existing one. The result is that an architecture change won't take effect until the guest is shutdown and booted again.</p> <p>This can be fixed by making the "arch" command do a config update as well.</p> | | |
