In case anyone is interested I intend to follow a method similar to that used by Individual Pubs Ltd as described here:

http://www.individualpubs.co.uk/bitcoin.html

That is:

- * BitFolk Ltd will be using the services of Andrew Smith as a sole trader as a bitcoin payment gateway
- * customer will be presented with a unique payment address per transaction with QR code for those using mobile wallets
- * A regularly-updated BTC/GBP exchange rate will be fetched from Bitstamp and used to calculate a BTC amount for any given payment
- * Once the correct BTC amount is paid to the address the invoice(s) will be marked paid
- * The invoice will remain in GBP and show VAT as usual

The only real downside of this method is that overpayments are tricky to support. It may be possible to agree via support ticket an address to send change back to. In practice given that hardly anyone will pay by BTC I don't see this being a big problem.
